CADWELL's Company (K), in the 22d Regiment of the New York Volunteer Militia (Foot), commanded by COLONEL WALTER PHELPS, JR., organized under a law of the State of New York, entitled, "An Act to authorize the embodying and equipment of a Volunteer Militia, and to provide for the Public Defense," passed April 16, 1861; and called into the service of the United States by the President, under the act of Congress approved February 28, 1795, from the 6th day of June, 1861, (date of this muster) for the term of two years, unless sooner discharged.
